

# KS4 RRR Timetable

These are tasks that you are set to complete out of normal lesson time.

**Retrieval**, this is when you are set tasks that require you to recall knowledge previously learnt.

**Repetition**, this is when you practice specific tasks and activities, requiring you to apply your knowledge and understanding.

**Reading**, these tasks promote the importance of reading across all subject areas. It exposes you to subject specific vocabulary in a variety of contexts.



**Revision**, this additional R will appear where your class teachers are using specific revision strategies to support your preparation for an assessment or exam.
